GAME SUMMARY

After a rough start and trailing by as many as three touchdowns, the Texans pulled off a thrilling 31-28 comeback victory, complete with a ILB **Brian Cushing** pick-six, a fake punt, and 41-yard field goal as time expired.

In the Monday night season opener at San Diego, QB **Matt Schaub** finished with 346 passing yards, three touchdowns and a quarterback rating of 110.0.

WR **Andre Johnson** topped the receiving corps with 146 yards on 12 receptions. The Houston tight ends came up big with three touchdowns, two to **Owen Daniels** and one to **Garrett Graham**.

RB **Arian Foster** led in rushing with 57 yards on 18 carries and had six receptions for 33 yards. **Ben Tate** carried the ball nine times for 55 yards.

The rough start began on the very first play of the game, when Schaub's pass intended for Daniels was deflected and intercepted. QB **Philip Rivers** found the end zone on the very next play, connecting with RB **Ryan Mathews** on a 14-yard touchdown pass.

Houston's offense remained scoreless until its third drive of the game when Daniels caught the first of his two touchdowns. A 1-yard pass from Schaub tied the score at 7-7 with 3:11 remaining in the first quarter.

The Chargers regained the lead with a 6-yard pass from Rivers to WR **Eddie Royal**. San Diego continued to roll, scoring 21 unanswered points.

With 4:57 remaining in the third quarter, the Texans orchestrated their comeback. Schaub connected with Graham for a touchdown on a 7-yard pass up the middle, cutting the Chargers' lead to two scores, 28-14.

Daniels caught his second score of the night, a 9-yard pass from Schaub with 14:44 remaining in the fourth quarter.

Cushing came up big with the pick-six on an 18-yard interception, tying the score at 28.

K **Randy Bullock**, who missed a 51-yard field goal earlier in the game, connected on a 41-yarder as time expired to give the Texans the 31-28 win. For his last-second heroics, head coach **Gary Kubiak** awarded Bullock with the game ball.

Bullock was perfect on all four point after tries, and drove four of his five kickoffs out for touchbacks.

It was the Texans' first-ever victory against San Diego.

GAME SUMMARY

Rookie WR **DeAndre Hopkins** caught the game-winning touchdown, a 3-yard pass from QB **Matt Schaub**, in overtime to give Houston a 30-24 win against the Tennessee Titans. Hopkins ended his second NFL game with seven catches for 117 yards, the second-highest receiving total for a rookie in franchise history.

WR **Andre Johnson** left the game with just over two minutes remaining in the fourth quarter after a hit by Titans S **Bernard Pollard**.

K **Randy Bullock**, who kicked the game-winning 41-yard field goal at San Diego in Week 1, missed two 50-yarders in the first half. Following two timeouts called by Tennessee to ice him, Bullock missed a potential game-winning 46-yarder, hitting the left upright, as time expired.

Schaub was 26-of-48 for 298 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions. Running backs **Arian Foster** and **Ben Tate** ran for a combined 172 yards. Tate led with 93 yards on nine carries. Foster scored the lone rushing touchdown, a 1-yard score, as well as a successful two-point conversion to tie the game 24-24 with 1:56 remaining in the fourth quarter.

Both teams put points on the board early, scoring on 80-yard opening drives. Schaub connected with TE **Garrett Graham** for a 1-yard touchdown, following a career-high 60-yard run by Tate on the drive. Titans WR **Kendall Wright** scored first for the Titans on a 6-yard pass from QB **Jake Locker**. Tennessee would not score again until their last drive of the half, giving them a 10-7 lead entering the break.

Head coach **Gary Kubiak** threw down the red flag in the third quarter, challenging a play which initially ruled Titans RB **Chris Johnson** down at Tennessee's 1-yard line. The ruling was overturned, resulting in a Houston safety by ILB **Joe Mays** on Johnson.

The Texans defense held the Tennessee to just 4 yards of total offense in the third quarter and Houston re-gained the lead when Schaub threw a 12-yard touchdown to TE **Owen Daniels**.

The Titans gained life in the fourth quarter, scoring 14 unanswered points. Locker orchestrated a nine-play, 99-yard drive that resulted in a 12-yard touchdown pass to TE **Delanie Walker**. Less than two minutes later, a miscommunication between Schaub and Hopkins resulted in a 23-yard pick-six by Titans CB **Altairraun Verner**.

Hopkins then went on a 64-yard tear on three consecutive catches on the following drive. Schaub's 21-yard pass along the sideline to Johnson was first ruled incomplete. A second red flag challenge by Kubiak resulted in an overturned call that rewarded Houston with a first down on Tennessee's 2-yard line. Johnson, who was injured on the play, jogged off the field, but did not return to the game.

After a 1-yard touchdown run and a successful two-point conversion by Foster, Houston tied up the score 24-24. Hopkins' 3-yard touchdown catch in overtime capped the seventh-consecutive win for the Texans in one-score games in the regular season.

ILB **Brian Cushing** had 1.5 sacks and led the defense with 13 tackles. DE **J.J. Watt** had two sacks, two passes defended and eight tackles.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans remained winless at Baltimore's M&T Bank Stadium after suffering their first loss of the season. Houston was unable to comeback for a third-straight week for the win, falling to the Ravens 30-9.

Mistakes marred Houston's loss in which Baltimore scored on a pick-six and punt return. The Texans had 14 penalties for 113 yards.

QB **Matt Schaub** and the Texans offense struggled without All-Pro LT **Duane Brown**, who did not make the trip due to a toe injury. Schaub was sacked three times for a loss of 24 yards. Schaub was 25-of-35 for 194 yards and one interception.

K **Randy Bullock** was 3-for-3 on field goal attempts, connecting from 27, 29, and 47 yards.

Baltimore QB **Joe Flacco**, who was without starting RB **Ray Rice**, was 16-of-24 for 171 yards. Rice's absence went relatively unnoticed as RB **Bernard Pierce** rushed for 65 yards and one touchdown. The Ravens' special teams and defense contributed 14 points in the second quarter.

The Texans defense kept Baltimore scoreless through the first quarter, forcing three-and-outs on the first two possessions.

GAME SUMMARY

In a game that seemed in control with the Texans leading 20-3 at the half, Seattle reeled off 20 unanswered points in the second half and overtime for a 23-20 win.

Houston lost its second game in a row and dropped to 2-2 on the season. Turnovers continued to haunt Houston as the Seahawks scored 10 points off three takeaways.

Seattle scored first with a 48-yard field goal in the first quarter. The Texans scored 20 unanswered points to dominate early.

Seattle's defense, ranked first in the NFL, had previously only allowed an average of nine points, 146 passing yards, and 241.7 total yards. The Texans offense surpassed that before halftime with 20 points, 226 yards passing, and 324 net yards.

After an early interception on a deflected pass intended for TE **Owen Daniels**, QB **Matt Schaub** bounced back for touchdown passes on consecutive drives. Schaub connected with TE **Garrett Graham** for a 31-yard score. A 5-yard toss to RB **Arian Foster** extended the Texans lead to 14-3 following a 10-play, 80-yard drive in the second quarter.

LB **Brian Cushing's** hit on RB **Marshawn Lynch** on Seattle's next series caused a fumble, which was recovered by NT **Terrell McClain**. The Texans converted the turnover when K **Randy Bullock** kicked a 22-yard field goal. Bullock added a 42-yarder as time expired in the first half for a 20-3 lead.

The Seahawks answered in the second half. After a fumble by RB **Ben Tate**, the Texans defense held Seattle to zero yards on four plays. The Seahawks settled for a **Steven Hauschka** 39-yard field goal. Lynch, who had 17 carries for 98 yards on the day, added a 3-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter. Seattle trailed 20-13 with 7:43 remaining in the game.

CB **Johnathan Joseph** intercepted QB **Russell Wilson's** pass at the 5:13 mark of the fourth quarter. The momentum shift was short-lived. After four consecutive carries by Foster, Schaub's pass on third-and-4, intended for Daniels, was intercepted by CB **Richard Sherman** and returned 58 yards for a game-tying touchdown.

The Texans headed to overtime for the second time in as many home games. Houston received the ball first in overtime but was unable to score on its first two possessions.

A 15-yard unnecessary roughness penalty on CB **Kareem Jackson** extended Seattle's second possession. Hauschka kicked a game-winning 45-yard field goal on the eight-play, 42-yard drive to win the game 23-20.

Both Foster and Johnson eclipsed 100 yards in the game. Foster rushed for 102 yards on 27 carries and caught six passes for 69 yards and one touchdown. Johnson had nine receptions for 110 yards on the day. Schaub was 31-of-49 for 355 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions.

Wilson, held to just 24 yards passing in the first half, finished 12-of-23 for 123 yards, one interception and a 49.7 passer rating but scrambled for 77 yards on 10 carries. Lynch added 98 yards rushing on 17 attempts.

GAME SUMMARY

It was a long, hard night for Houston that started on the third play from scrimmage. QB **Matt Schaub** threw an interception that was returned for a touchdown and the 49ers never looked back in the 34-3 rout.

Schaub threw two more interceptions before being spelled by QB **T.J. Yates** in the fourth quarter.

Schaub threw his fourth pick-six in as many games while San Francisco built a 21-0 lead. Houston's offense remained scoreless until K **Randy Bullock** kicked a 41-yard field goal in the third quarter.

GAME SUMMARY

The Houston Texans lost their fourth-straight game in an unpredictable fashion.

The St. Louis offense, defense, and special teams each scored in the Rams' 38-13 victor. The Rams found the end zone on three touchdowns by QB **Sam Bradford**, a fumbled kickoff return and an interception return.

Despite putting up 420 yards of total offense, the Texans only found the end zone once. Houston committed four turnovers; two fumbles and two interceptions. St. Louis returned two of those for touchdowns.

QB **Matt Schaub** was 15-of-21 for 186 yards and a passer rating of 98.5 before leaving the game with an injury. With 3:54 remaining in third quarter, Schaub was sacked by DE **Chris Long** and did not return to the game.

QB **T.J. Yates** took over but struggled, throwing the team's fifth pick-six in as many games on his first drive. Yates completed 11-of-16 passes for 98 yards and had two interceptions.

In the first half, Houston's offense moved the ball successfully but was unable to score. RB **Arian Foster** shined with 98 yards rushing on 10 carries and two catches for 46 yards. Schaub was 11-of-14 for 153 yards. Penalties plagued the Texans who committed seven for 95 yards before halftime.

St. Louis scored first on a 65-yard drive that was extended 40 yards by pass interference penalty on CB **Kareem Jackson**. Bradford threw a 2-yard touchdown pass to TE **Cory Harkey** to give the Rams a 7-0 lead in the first quarter.

Schaub marched the Texans down the field on Houston's second offensive series, but a fumble by WR **DeAndre Hopkins** following a 12-yard catch ended the drive. Rams LB **James Laurinaitis** recovered the fumble. K **Greg Zuerlein** kicked a 42-yard field goal and St. Louis gained a 10-0 lead with 13:22 remaining in the second quarter.

Texans K **Randy Bullock** was successful on both of his field goal attempts, kicking from 20 and 35 yards. The Texans trailed 17-6 at halftime. In the second half, the Texans eliminated their penalties but continued to make costly mistakes.

In the third quarter, St. Louis scored back-to-back touchdowns in six seconds. Bradford found WR **Brian Quick** in the endzone on a 2-yard touchdown pass. On the ensuing kickoff, WR **Keshawn Martin** fumbled the return. LB **Daren Bates** returned the fumble for an 11-yard touchdown, giving the Rams a 31-6 lead with 7:36 remaining in the third quarter.

When Schaub left the game, Yates took over at the St. Louis 23-yard line. On the same drive, Yates was picked off by LB **Alec Ogletree**, who returned it 98 yards for a touchdown. St. Louis increased its lead to 38-6 with 0:50 remaining in the third quarter with the two scores. Yates threw a second interception before leading Houston to its first touchdown of the game, a 1-yard run by RB **Ben Tate** in the fourth quarter.

Bradford was 12-of-16 for 117 yards and three touchdown passes. RB **Zac Stacy** rushed for 79 yards on 18 carries.

Foster had 20 carries for 141 yards of rushing and four catches for 57 yards. Foster had a 41-yard gain, his longest since 2011, on a short pass from Schaub. WR **Andre Johnson** led the receivers with seven catches for 88 yards.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans dropped their fifth-straight game, losing to Kansas City 17-16 at Arrowhead Stadium despite a stellar debut from QB **Case Keenum** and big plays by the defense. Houston lost ILB **Brian Cushing** to a season-ending knee injury and RB **Arian Foster** left the game with a hamstring injury following the Texans' first offensive series.

Keenum was 15-of-25 passing for 271 yards, one touchdown and no interceptions for a 110.6 passer rating. It was the most passing yards for a quarterback in his first start for the Texans, surpassing **Matt Schaub's** previous record of 225 yards against Kansas City on Sept. 9, 2007.

The Houston defense forced two turnovers effectively, ending its two-game takeaway drought. DE **J.J. Watt** forced Chiefs RB **Jamaal Charles** to fumble in the third quarter. CB **Kareem Jackson** recovered Charles' fumble to set up a 21-yard field goal by K **Randy Bullock**. In the fourth quarter, FS **Shiloh Keo** intercepted **Alex Smith** on third down.

Keenum led the Texans on scoring drives on his first two possessions. Houston scored first on a 48-yard field goal by **Bullock**, who was 3-of-3 on the day. The former University of Houston quarterback then threw a 29-yard touchdown pass to rookie WR **DeAndre Hopkins** to give the Texans an early 10-7 lead. The five-play, 81-yard drive was extended by a 49-yard catch by WR **DeVier Posey**.

Foster had 4 carries for 11 yards before leaving in the middle of the first quarter. RB **Ben Tate**, who suffered a rib injury, finished with 50 yards rushing on 15 attempts and 5 yards receiving on two catches.

Charles rushed for 86 yards on 21 carries and one touchdown. Charles scored first for Kansas City on a 1-yard touchdown run in the first quarter. Smith ran in the Chiefs' second touchdown on a fake handoff to cap a 15-play, 97-yard drive. The Chiefs headed into halftime with a 14-10 lead.

In the second half, Houston held Kansas City to just one field goal.

Watt led the defense with six tackles, one forced fumble, and one sack. NT **Earl Mitchell** also added a sack for a loss of 6 yards.

WR **Andre Johnson** finished with 89 yards receiving on four catches. Hopkins finished with three receptions for 76 yards and one touchdown.

Smith was 23-of-34 for 240 yards passing, one rushing touchdown, and one interception.

Chiefs WR **Dwayne Bowe** caught five passes for 66 yards. The Chiefs defense sacked Keenum five times and had one fumble recovery late in the fourth quarter.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans were primed for a win but dropped their sixth-straight game in a hard-fought 27-24 loss to the Indianapolis Colts.

It was a bizarre night in which head coach **Gary Kubiak** collapsed at halftime and was rushed to a Houston-area hospital. As the team headed to the locker room, Kubiak went down. He was examined by team doctors and then taken in an ambulance, accompanied by family to the hospital. Defensive Coordinator **Wade Phillips** was acting head coach in Kubiak's absence.

Under an open roof at Reliant Stadium, QB **Case Keenum** led the Texans offense in Battle Red jerseys in front of a franchise-record 71,778 fans. WR **Andre Johnson** caught nine passes for 229 yards and a career-high three touchdown passes.

The defense sacked **Andrew Luck** four times on the night. DE **Antonio Smith** recorded two sacks while DE **J.J. Watt** and ILB **Joe Mays** added one each. Watt also blocked a field goal by **K Adam Vinatieri** on the Colts' opening series, which was returned 37 yards by SS **D.J. Swearinger**. Following the blocked field goal, Indianapolis punted on its next four possessions. Vinatieri's 30-yarder field goal in the first half was the only score for the Colts.

In the end, it wasn't enough. After a dominant first half, the Texans lost momentum when Luck picked up speed and Houston's offense failed to find the end zone.

In his home debut, Keenum threw three touchdown passes to Johnson to give Houston a 21-3 lead heading into halftime. In the second half, Luck threw three touchdowns to wide receiver **T.Y. Hilton** while the Texans offense was only able to put up a field goal.

Luck ended the game 18-of-40 for 271 yards passing and a passer rating of 92.8.

Texans **K Randy Bullock** was 1-of-4 on field goal attempts. Bullock was successful from 43 yards but missed from 49, 43, and 55 yards. Bullock's final game-tying, 55-yard attempt went wide left as time expired.

Keenum was 20-of-34 for 350 yards passing with three touchdowns and a 123.4 passer rating.

GAME SUMMARY

Houston dropped its seventh-straight game for the first time in franchise history, falling to the Arizona Cardinals 27-24.

After a disastrous start for the Texans' offense that resulted in a Cardinal touchdown on the first play of the game, QB **Case Keenum** threw for three touchdowns, including two to WR **Andre Johnson**. Houston's defense forced a season-high three turnovers. DE **J.J. Watt** had one sack and forced and recovered two fumbles. Rookie SS **D.J. Swearinger** had his first career NFL interception.

The Texans struggled to move the ball offensively in the second half. After a dismal third quarter with no first downs and zero net yards on offense, big plays gave the Texans a jump-start in the fourth quarter. Watt's second fumble recovery gave the Texans possession in the red zone and led to a 5-yard touchdown pass to Johnson.

Mounting injuries also plagued Houston. Without starting RB **Arian Foster**, a banged-up **Ben Tate** started and finished with 56 yards on 15 carries and three catches for 8 yards. More injuries took place as CB **Kareem Jackson** left with a rib injury in the first half after recording four solo tackles. ILB **Joe Mays** suffered an oblique injury and rookie TE **Ryan Griffin** took a hit on the opening kickoff of the second half and was ruled out with a concussion.

On the first play of the game, Keenum was sacked and had the ball stripped by LB **John Abraham**. LB **Matt Shaughnessy** recovered the fumble and returned it 6 yards to give the Cardinals a 7-0 lead.

Two drives later, Johnson caught the 60th touchdown of his career on a 7-yard pass from Keenum. The Texans offense moved the ball 49 yards on eight plays for its first score.

The Cardinals found the end zone again in the second quarter as QB **Carson Palmer** threw a 12-yard touchdown to TE **Rob Housler**.

Houston fired back with 10 unanswered points in the second quarter. The ensuing 80-yard drive ended in Griffin's first career NFL touchdown. Keenum completed passes to four different receivers on the drive: Andre Johnson, WR **DeAndre Hopkins**, Tate, and RB **Dennis Johnson**.

Two plays later, Swearinger had his first career interception off Palmer to give Houston possession at the Arizona 45-yard line. K **Randy Bullock's** 48-yard field goal tied his career high and gave the Texans their first lead of the game, 17-14 with 6:36 remaining in the second quarter.

Watt's sack on Palmer forced a fumble with 0:43 remaining in the first half. The Texans, however, were unable to capitalize on their second turnover. Bullock's second field goal attempt, a 40-yarder, was deflected by **Justin Bethel** as time expired in the half.

Houston struggled in the second half on both sides of the ball. The offense had a net gain of zero yards in the third quarter. Tate was sidelined but returned in the fourth quarter. The defense allowed the Cardinals to put up points on their next three drives. Arizona added two field goals in the third quarter with kicks from 35 and 20 yards. Palmer's 19-yard touchdown pass to WR **Andre Roberts** capped off a nine-play, 67-yard drive that consumed 4:48. Houston trailed 27-17 in the fourth quarter for its largest deficit of the day.

On the Cardinals' next offensive series, RB **Rashard Mendenhall's** fumble gave Houston some much-needed momentum. Recovered by Watt for his second of the game, the Texans took over at the Arizona 5-yard line. Twelve seconds later, Keenum's 5-yard touchdown pass to Johnson closed in on Arizona to get Houston to within three points.

With no timeouts remaining, Houston regained possession in the final two minutes. On fourth-and-3, Keenum was unable to complete a pass to Hopkins. Arizona took over on downs and ran out the clock.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans lost to the Oakland Raiders 28-23 at Reliant Stadium.

Oakland jumped to a 14-0 lead in the first quarter, converting a pair of takeaways into touchdowns. The first came when Texans TE **Garrett Graham** was stripped by S **Charles Woodson** on the third play of the game. Raiders CB **Phillip Adams** scooped up the loose ball and returned it 26 yards to the Houston 16. Six plays later, Oakland rookie QB **Matt McGloin** threw his first career touchdown pass on a 5-yarder to WR **Denarius Moore**.

Two possessions later, Texans QB **Case Keenum** was picked off by LB **Nick Roach**. It was Keenum's first career interception after 105 consecutive attempts without a pick. On the following play, WR **Rod Streater** caught McGloin's second touchdown pass of the day to give Oakland a 14-0 lead with 3:45 remaining in the first quarter.

The Texans gained momentum in the second quarter, scoring 17 unanswered points with some big plays on offense and special team. Keenum eluded the pass rush and stopped short of the right sideline to unload a 42-yard touchdown pass to Graham to cut the lead to 14-7.

WR **Keshawn Martin** evened the score with a franchise-record 87-yard punt return for a touchdown at the 2:54 mark of the second quarter. The Texans defense forced a punt on the ensuing Oakland possession. Houston took over at its own 24 and drove 43 yards to set up a career-long 51-yard field goal by K **Randy Bullock** with :40 left in the first half.

Oakland regained the lead with McGloin's third touchdown pass of the day, a 26-yarder to TE **Mychal Rivera** with 8:19 remaining in the third quarter. The Raiders provided what would be the winning points two possessions later on an 80-yard run from RB **Rashad Jennings** on a direct snap for a 28-17 lead.

QB **Matt Schaub** was inserted into the lineup on the Texans' next possession and led the team on a pair of fourth-quarter drives that resulted in 26- and 30-yard field goals from Bullock to pull within 28-23.

Houston's defense tied a franchise record by holding the Raiders to 2 yards of offense in the fourth quarter and kept the offense in the game until the final minutes of regulation.

The Texans' last chance came at its own 36-yard line with 3:43 remaining. Schaub led the team as far as the Oakland 2 but could get no further. A failed third-and-1 attempt from the 2 was followed by a run for a loss of a yard, a false start and an incompletion in the end zone to WR **Andre Johnson** with 1:10 remaining.

McGloin took three knees to run out the clock and preserve the win for the Raiders.

Keenum finished 12-of-25 for 155 yards, one touchdown and an interception. Schaub was 13-of-24 for 170 yards. RB **Ben Tate** ran for 88 yards on 19 carries for the Texans. Graham set a franchise record for a tight end with 136 yards receiving on seven receptions. ILB **Darryl Sharpton** led the defense with a franchise-record 19 tackles.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans dropped their ninth-straight game, falling to Jacksonville 13-6.

K **Randy Bullock** led the Texans with field goals from 49 and 20 yards. Rookie RB **Dennis Johnson** rushed for 74 yards on 13 carries. TE **Garrett Graham** led the Texans with five catches for 32 yards. QB **Case Keenum** was 18-of-34 for 169 yards and one interception which came on Houston's final drive. DE **J.J. Watt** recorded a sack for the fifth straight game and blocked his second field goal of the season.

Jacksonville RB **Maurice Jones-Drew** had his best game of the year with 14 carries for 84 yards and one touchdown and caught six passes for 60 yards. QB **Chad Henne** was 23-of-32 for 239 passing. WR **Cecil Shorts** led the Jaguars with eight catches for 71 yards.

On the first play of the game, Texans DE **Antonio Smith** and NT **Earl Mitchell** sacked Henne for a loss of 7 yards. Henne answered two plays later with a 51-yard pass to rookie WR **Ace Sanders** to set up first-and-goal from the 8-yard line. Four plays later, Jones-Drew plunged in from a yard out on fourth down for a 7-0 lead with 10:57 remaining in the first quarter.

Jacksonville extended the lead to 10-0 with a 30-yard field goal from **Josh Scobee** at the 8:01 mark of the second quarter. Jones-Drew began the 73-yard drive with a 44-yard run.

Houston punted on its first five possessions but gained momentum on its last series of the first half. Johnson churned out 47 yards on four consecutive rushes to start the drive to take Houston to the Jacksonville 33. Keenum extended the drive with a 2-yard gain on third-and-one. But it was as far as the Texans would get and the team settled for a 49-yard field goal by Bullock to cut the lead to 10-3 with :33 remaining in the first half.

Keenum moved the offense 83 yards on the first drive to start the second half. The drive stalled at the 2-yard line, leaving Bullock to convert a 20-yard field goal attempt that made it 10-6 with 8:29 remaining in the third quarter.

Jacksonville's next drive was kept alive with a roughing the passer penalty on third-and-10. Smith's hit on Henne extended the drive to set up another Scobee field goal attempt. Watt blocked the 49-yarder and FS **Shiloh Keo** returned it 25 yards with 0:57 remaining in the third quarter.

Keenum and the offense took over at the Jaguars' 49-yard line but the field position but could not capitalize as the drive ended on a failed fourth-and-one attempt. Houston challenged the spot but the call stood and Jacksonville took over at its 40-yard line.

A pass intended for WR **Keshawn Martin** was intercepted by DE **Ryan Davis** with 0:34 remaining to end the drive and Houston's hopes to tie the game.

GAME SUMMARY

The Houston Texans' highest offensive output since Week 1 wasn't enough in a 34-31 loss to the New England Patriots at Reliant Stadium. Houston's offense set a franchise record with four rushing touchdowns, including three from RB **Ben Tate**, who ran for a season-high 102 yards on 22 carries.

Houston jumped out to a 10-0 lead and led as late as the halfway mark of the fourth quarter before New England K **Stephen Gostkowski** used a pair of 53-yard field goals to erase a 31-28 deficit and send the Texans to their 10th-straight loss. The game featured five lead changes, including four in a see-saw second half.

Texans WR **Andre Johnson** caught eight passes for 121 yards and became the second-fastest player in NFL history to reach 900 receptions, doing so in his 150th career game. QB **Case Keenum** scored his first career rushing touchdown on a 5-yard dash in the third quarter and completed 15-of-30 passes for 272 yards and an interception.

New England QB **Tom Brady** led a 27-point second-half surge and finished the game with 371 yards through the air on 29-of-41 passing with two touchdowns and one interception for a 104.8 passer rating. WR **Julian Edelman** led the visitors with nine receptions for 101 yards and TE **Rob Gronkowski** pulled in six passes for 127 yards and a touchdown.

Tate opened the scoring with an 8-yard jaunt at the 8:44 mark of the first quarter to give Houston a 7-0 lead. Texans CB **Johnathan Joseph** picked off Brady on the ensuing possession and returned the interception to the Patriots' 31-yard line. K **Randy Bullock** converted a 43-yard attempt three plays later for a 10-0 lead.

New England answered with a six-play, 55 yard drive that ended with a diving 23-yard touchdown grab by Gronkowski to trim the lead to 10-7. The scoring ceased until Tate meandered 20 yards for his second touchdown of the day with 1:47 remaining in the first half for a 17-7 Texans lead that held until early in the third quarter.

Brady opened the second half by marching the Patriots 78 yards in five plays to bring New England within 17-14. He was 3-for-3 for 78 yards on the drive, including a 50-yard pass to Gronkowski, FB **James Develin** finished the drive with a bruising 1-yard touchdown run. Following a three-and-out by the Texans, Brady led another touchdown drive that ended with a 9-yard scoring grab by RB **Shane Vereen** that gave the Patriots a 21-17 lead.

The Texans answered with a 10-play, 81-yard scoring drive that ate up 5:55 on the clock. Houston ran seven times on the drive, with Keenum converting twice on third-and-one on the ground. Keenum's second conversion came on a designed keeper around the left end from the 5 for his first career touchdown run and a 24-21 lead.

RB **LeGarrette Blount** reclaimed the lead for New England with a 7-yard run at the 13:14 mark of the fourth quarter. It only took three plays for Houston to grab the lead back. Keenum began the drive with a 66-yard completion to WR **DeAndre Hopkins**. Tate covered the remaining 14 yards on the ground and took the lead with his franchise-record-tying third touchdown of the game.

The Texans' defense slowed down the Patriots on their next two drives but couldn't stop them. Gostkowski's first 53-yarder tied the game at 31-31 with 7:16 remaining. His second came at the 3:12 mark and proved to be the game-winner.

GAME SUMMARY

The Houston Texans lost their seventh consecutive game by a touchdown or less in a 27-20 loss to Jacksonville at EverBank Field on NFL Network's Thursday Night Football. Texans QB **Matt Schaub** spelled starter **Case Keenum** in the third quarter but was unable lead the team back from a 24-10 deficit.

Schaub brought the Texans within 24-20, leading the team to scores on his first two drives. But a failed fourth-down attempt at the Jacksonville 13 and an interception on Houston's next possession with 2:16 to play sent the Texans to an 11th-straight loss.

The Texans tied a franchise record with 14 penalties for a record 177 yards. Seven of Houston's penalties gave the Jaguars first downs and extended drives, negating the Texans' 406-281 advantage in total yards and 35:22 of possession.

Texans WR **Andre Johnson** posted his 10th career game with at least 10 receptions and more than 150 yards receiving, tying Jerry Rice's NFL record. Johnson finished with 13 receptions for 154 yards, also marking his 50th career 100-yard game. Schaub completed 17-of-29 passes for 198 yards and Keenum was 16-of-29 for 159 yards. Both had one touchdown pass and one interception. TE **Garrett Graham** tied a career-high with eight receptions and had 73 yards.

The Jaguars built a 14-0 lead on a pair of QB **Chad Henne** touchdown passes. Henne marched the Jaguars 80 yards on 13 plays to open the game and capped the drive with a 1-yard scoring toss to TE **Marcedes Lewis** on third-and-goal. Two possessions later, Jacksonville trekked 86 yards in just 1:30. Lewis caught a 41-yard pass on the first play of the series to cross midfield. WR **Cecil Shorts III** drew a 33-yard pass interference penalty on FS **Shiloh Keo** to take the ball to the Houston 12. Following a short run by RB **Maurice Jones-Drew** and another Texans penalty, Henne hit shorts with a 6-yard yardage strike to make it 14-0.

Keenum carved into the lead by engineering one of the longest drives of the season for the Texans. He completed 7-of-8 passes for 76 yards on a 12-play, 91-yard drive that ate up 6:57 on the clock. WR **Keshawn Martin** finished the drive with an 8-yard touchdown reception with 1:56 left in the first half to make it 14-7.

The Texans got the ball back at their own 32 with 1:20 to play in the half but Jaguars CB **Alan Ball** picked off Keenum on the second play of the drive. The turnover and ensuing penalties proved costly for the Texans. S **D.J. Swearinger**'s taunting penalty on third down extended Jacksonville's drive and a defensive holding call negated SS **Eddie Pleasant**'s pick of Henne's pass on the next play. All that led to K **Josh Scobee**'s 40-yard field goal and a 17-7 Jacksonville lead at the half.

Houston K **Randy Bullock** trimmed the lead to 17-10 with a 34-yard field goal the Texans' second possession of the third quarter. Jacksonville answered with an 88-yard drive that ended with a 21-yard touchdown pass from WR **Ace Sanders** to RB **Jordan Todman** on a throwback to put Jacksonville up 24-10 with 6:18 left in the third quarter.

Schaub entered the game at the 4:10 mark and promptly drove the Texans 76 yards on seven plays, hitting Graham with a 5-yard touchdown pass to bring Houston within 24-17. The Texans forced a three-and-out on Jacksonville's ensuing possession and got the ball back at the 14:52 mark of the fourth quarter. Bullock cut the gap to 24-20 with a 31-yard field goal at the 11:34 mark.

It was as close as the Texans would get. Houston forced another three-and-out on defense but the offense stalled deep in Jacksonville territory and turned ball over on downs at the 3:45 mark with a chance to take the lead as Schaub's pass to Johnson fell incomplete. Scobee added a 39-yard field goal following Schaub's interception to seal the win.

GAME SUMMARY

The Houston Texans were held to 239 yards of offense in a 25-3 loss to the Indianapolis Colts at Lucas Oil Stadium. Texans QB **Case Keenum** was picked off twice by CB **Darius Butler** and Houston was unable to overcome a 20-3 halftime deficit despite a stellar defensive effort in the second half.

Indianapolis converted twice on third-and-1 on its opening drive, marching 80 yards on 11 plays to take a 7-0 lead at the 9:31 mark of the first quarter. RB **Donald Brown** took the Colts into Texans territory with a 26-yard run to the Houston 34-yard line and Colts QB **Andrew Luck** finished the drive with a 14-yard touchdown pass to WR **Griff Whalen** eight plays later to open up the scoring.

After a three-and-out by Houston's offense, Indianapolis was moving the ball again before Texans CB **Johnathan Joseph** picked off his team-leading third pass of the season. Joseph snared Luck's pass at the 5-yard line and returned it 32 yards. K **Randy Bullock** got the Texans on the board seven plays later with a 49-yard field goal with 1:46 remaining in the first quarter.

The Colts pushed the lead to 10-3 with a 37-yard field goal from K **Adam Vinatieri** with 12 minutes remaining in the first half. Butler picked off Keenum at the Houston 30-yard line and returned it 13 yards to set up the score. RB **Trent Richardson** put the Colts up 17-3 with 7:03 remaining in the second quarter, taking shovel pass from Luck 9 yards for the score.

Indianapolis pushed the lead to 20-3, converting another Keenum interception into points. Keenum's pass intended for WR **Andre Johnson** was picked off by Butler at the Colts' 31-yard line and returned to the Houston 44 with 2:55 remaining in the half. Vinatieri connected from 43 yards out for his second field goal of the day six plays later.

The Texans didn't fare any better in the second half, punting after three plays on their first possession. Whalen returned **Shane Lechler's** 53-yard punt 51 yards to the Houston 28-yard line. Houston's defense stalled the Colts, who settled for a 40-yard field goal by Vinatieri and a 23-3 lead.

Colts DE **Robert Mathis** gave the Colts a 25-3 lead at the 1:59 mark of the third quarter, with a sack-fumble on Keenum in the end zone. Texans LT **Duane Brown** recovered the ball in the end zone for Colts safety.

Houston's defense held Indianapolis 124 yards and 0-for-7 on third downs in the second half but it wasn't enough as the Texans offense was unable to generate a first down until the fourth quarter.

Keenum finished the game 19-of-34 passing for 168 yards. Rookie TE **Ryan Griffin** led the Texans with career highs of six receptions for 62 yards.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans fell 37-13 to the Denver Broncos in the final home game of the 2013 season at Reliant Stadium. A 16-13 game was busted open in the fourth quarter with 21 unanswered points from the visitors.

History was made for both teams as Texans WR **Andre Johnson** recorded his 100th catch of the season in the first quarter to tie WR **Wes Welker** for most 100-reception seasons in NFL history (5). Broncos QB **Peyton Manning** broke **Tom Brady's** single-season record with his 51st touchdown pass of the season in the fourth quarter.

It was a slow start for Texans QB **Matt Schaub**, who made his first start since Week 6 against St. Louis. Schaub completed 18-of-37 passes for 176 yards for one touchdown and two interceptions.

In the first half, the Texans never trailed by more than 10 points despite being held to five first downs and 83 yards of total offense. Houston cleaned up its mistakes from the previous weeks with zero penalties in the first half while the Texans defense stalled the Broncos on their two trips inside the red zone before the half, limiting the NFL's top offense to three field goals and a 36-yard touchdown pass from Manning to **Demaryius Thomas** on the first play of the second quarter.

Texans K **Randy Bullock** kept the home team within striking distance with a pair of first-half field goals. Bullock knocked through a 45-yarder to tie the game at 3-3 in the first quarter and trimmed the Broncos' lead to 10-6 with a 35-yard field goal at the 6:06 mark of the second quarter.

The Broncos pushed the lead to 16-6 before the half with a pair of field goals in the final 56 seconds before intermission. Denver K **Matt Prater** ended a 13-play, 69-yard drive with a 25-yard field goal. Houston failed to move the ball on the ensuing possession and ate up just 30 seconds of clock before punting after three plays. It left plenty of time for Manning, who took over at the Denver 31 and marched the Broncos 43 yards on four plays to set up a 44-yard field goal by Prater as time expired in the first half.

In the third quarter, Schaub threw his only touchdown of the game while the defense held Manning to just 38 yards and one first down. Schaub capped a nine-play, 74-yard drive with a 15-yard scoring strike to WR **Keshawn Martin** in the back of the end zone to cut the lead to 16-13 with 10:33 remaining in the third quarter.

It was as close as the Texans would get.

The game slipped away from the Texans in the fourth quarter in a lopsided finish. Schaub threw two interceptions and Manning added three touchdowns, including two to WR **Eric Decker**. Manning's final score was his 51st touchdown of the season, a 25-yard pass to TE **Julius Thomas**, breaking Brady's single-season record.

GAME SUMMARY

The Texans fell 16-10 to the Titans in the final game of the season.

QB **Matt Schaub** started for **Case Keenum**, who was inactive due to a right thumb injury. Schaub completed 22-of-34 for 229 yards, but was picked off twice and lost a fumble on a center exchange.

The Texans, depleted by injuries, were led by RB **Jonathan Grimes**, who started his first career game. Grimes led the offense in both rushing and receiving, and scored the only touchdown of the game for the Texans. He finished with 16 carries for 50 yards and six receptions for 76 yards.

Houston gained 178 yards of net offense and 13 first downs in the first half but struggled in the second half. After a touchdown on their first possession of the game, the Texans remained scoreless until the fourth quarter as the Titans put up 16 unanswered points. Houston committed four turnovers and only had one takeaway, an interception by CB **Brice McCain**.

On their opening drive, Schaub led the Texans down the field on a nine-play, 63-yard drive. He completed all four of his passes before handing off to Grimes for his first career NFL touchdown on a 3-yard run. The Texans were staked to a 7-0 advantage, but would not score again until less than three minutes remained in the game.

K **Rob Bironas** was the lone scorer for the Titans in the first half, kicking a pair of field goals from 42 and 55 yards. He made a 55-yard attempt with 0:04 remaining in the second quarter, and the Texans held a 7-6 halftime lead.

Houston's first possession of the second half ended in its second turnover of the game. Schaub's pass, intended for rookie TE **Ryan Griffin**, bounced off S **Bernard Pollard's** facemask before it was intercepted by LB **Akeem Ayers**. The Titans took their first lead of the contest following the interception. RB **Chris Johnson's** 11-yard run capped a seven-play, 35-yard drive to give Tennessee a 13-7 lead with 5:39 remaining in the third quarter.

The Texans turned the ball over a third time when Schaub fumbled a fourth quarter snap from C **Chris Myers**. Bironas added his third field goal of the day, a 37-yarder, to extend the Titans' lead 16-7 with 10:44 remaining in the game.

Texans K **Randy Bullock** cut the lead to 16-10 with 2:50 remaining in the game with a 19-yard field at the end of an 8-play, 89-yard drive. Grimes added a 31-yard gain off a short pass from Schaub on the series. Houston's defense held on the ensuing Tennessee possession to give the Texans a chance at winning the game at their own 9-yard line.
