

# HOUSTON TEXANS MEDIA POLICY

## MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Media credentials will be granted based on the following guidelines:

1. Houston-area media agencies which cover the Houston Texans on a daily basis will receive top priority.
2. Media agencies which cover the opposing team as requested by the opposing team's public relations staff.
3. National media agencies which cover the National Football League regularly (includes online properties such as ESPN.com, Yahoo! Sports, CBSSports.com, etc.).
4. Daily or weekly newspapers with a circulation of at least 100,000.
5. Television stations with a nightly news show and a nightly sports segment.
6. Radio stations with a 24-hour sports format and are affiliated with a national radio network (i.e. ESPN, Sporting-News, Westwood One, etc.).
7. Daily or weekly newspapers with a circulation of at least 50,000.
8. Other requests not falling under one of the above categories will be considered on the basis of space availability in the NRG Stadium press box.
9. No freelance credentials will be granted.

Season-long credentials are issued in August; game-by-game credentials must be requested before 5 p.m. on the Tuesday prior to each home game. All credential requests must be submitted online at <http://media.houstontexans.com>.

## CREDENTIAL REQUESTS (ROAD GAMES)

If you are a regular member of the Houston media who wishes to cover the Texans on the road, submit your request for game credentials and parking passes through **Kevin Cooper** at [kevin.cooper@houstontexans.com](mailto:kevin.cooper@houstontexans.com). All requests must be submitted no later than one game prior to a road contest. Credentials will be distributed on either Wednesday or Thursday during open locker room.

## GAME DAY PARKING

Parking for Texans games must be applied for online at <http://media.houstontexans.com>. The appropriate parking pass will be required for access to media parking lots on game day.

## ENTRY ON GAME DAY

The media entrance at NRG Stadium is on the west side of the stadium on the corner of Kirby and Murworth. Enter the media entrance which is located just right of the Verizon VIP gate.

## WILL CALL

Media will call is located on the west side of the stadium at the corner of Kirby and Murworth. The media will call gate is located just right of the Verizon VIP gate. The appropriate game credential must be presented at the media entrance for admission into the stadium. Game credentials not picked up in advance will be available on game day at the credential will-call window. Please remember to bring valid identification. The window will open three hours prior to kickoff and bags will be checked upon entrance to the stadium.

## PHONES AND INTERNET

To request a phone on game day, contact **Jeff Schmitz** of the Houston Texans IT department at (832-667-2130) the week prior to the game. The Texans press box offers complimentary wireless Internet. If you have any questions on game day, see Schmitz at his post in the press box, located on the third level behind **Evan Koch** and **Kevin Cooper**.

## POSTGAME INTERVIEWS AND LOCKER ROOM ACCESS

Members of the media needing to conduct post game interviews will be given access to the Texans' and visiting interview rooms after the game, as well as the home and visiting locker rooms. **NO STILL PHOTOGRAPHERS OR AUTOGRAPHS ARE ALLOWED IN THE TEXANS LOCKER ROOM.** With six minutes remaining in the game, take the media elevator to the field level. Videographers without field access will be in the team auditorium for the duration of the game. **Bill O'Brien's** post-game interview session with the media will begin approximately 10 minutes following the conclusion of the game and will be held in the Texans Team Auditorium (white arrow). Electronic media covering the press conference are asked to use the multi-box to ease congestion at the podium. Both team locker rooms will be open to press bearing the proper credentials following the NFL-mandated 10-minute cooling-off period. The visiting head coach will be available in the visitor's interview room across from the visiting locker room.

To reach either locker room from the press box, simply take the elevator to the service level and follow proper direction arrows on the ground:

**Blue** - Texans locker room

**Red** - Visitors locker room

**White** - Texans post game press conference

## PHOTOGRAPHERS

Photographers who are credentialed on a season-long basis for sideline access will be required to wear a photo vest. Sideline access for NFL games is limited to photographers on assignment for recognized or sports publications. No one except network television personnel and authorized game personnel will be admitted to the field without a camera. All field photographers must remain outside the bench areas and outside the yellow border surrounding the playing field.

## MEDIA WORKROOM

The media workroom is located on the service level at NRG Stadium across from the Texans' locker room. The room is available to working media throughout the week. Phones, Texans information, NFL news releases and other information are available. Wireless service will be available in the media workroom.

## INTERVIEW REQUESTS

All interview requests for Houston Texans executives, coaches, and players should go through the Texans communications department.

Please give at least 48 hours for your request. For Texans players, assistant coaches and executives, please send your request to **Evan Koch** at [evan.koch@houstontexans.com](mailto:evan.koch@houstontexans.com) or call him at (832) 667-2050; or **Charles Hampton** at [charles.hampton@houstontexans.com](mailto:charles.hampton@houstontexans.com) or call him at (832) 667-2282.

Requests for owner Bob McNair, general manager Rick Smith and head coach Bill O'Brien should be sent to the attention of Senior Director of Communications **Kevin Cooper**. O'Brien's Monday news conference is held in the media workroom at 2:30 p.m. He speaks with the Texans' media after practice on Wednesday through Friday in the media workroom (time will be emailed out at the beginning of each week).

## OPEN LOCKER ROOM PERIODS

The Texans open locker room period is before practice on Wednesday and Thursday from 11:10-11:55 a.m. (time subject to change) on the service level of NRG Stadium. Friday's open locker room period begins at 11:00 a.m.

Special requests can be fulfilled on Monday or Tuesday, but it should be cleared with a member of the Texans communications department. You should give at least a week's notice for special arrangements on Monday and Tuesday. Everyone in the locker room must dress professionally and have a job function. The Texans communications department can remove any member of the media from the locker room for improper dress or unprofessional behavior.

## CONFERENCE CALLS

The Texans Communications Staff will record and transcribe all visiting team conference calls. Conference calls take place on Wednesday in the media workroom. Weekly updates of conference call participants and times will appear on <http://media.houstontexans.com>.

## PRACTICE REGULATIONS

Texans locker room and practices will be open to the media during the week as specified. We will provide a specific time during practice for shooting video.

## PARKING DURING THE WEEK

Parking for covering Texans weekly press conferences, open locker room or for access to the media workroom, use the Day Lot, located on the southeast corner of Kirby and Westridge. While covering practice, park in the Teal Lot on the northeast corner of Kirby and Murworth.

## LIVE SHOTS

### Monday-Friday

Live shots on NRG Park property must be set up through the Texans Communications Department in conjunction with SMG. Please contact Evan Koch at [evan.koch@houstontexans.com](mailto:evan.koch@houstontexans.com) or 281-605-9666 before setting up a live shot. Locations will be set up through the communications department. Please give the Texans 12 hours to ensure proper set up.

### Gameday

NFL network television partners and Texans media partners will be given priority for live shots at NRG Stadium. Television stations are allowed to shoot live at NRG Stadium until one hour before kickoff. Please get permission from Texans communications 48 hours before the game in order to shoot live.

NFL network television partners and Texans media partners are the only broadcast entities permitted to shoot live from inside NRG Stadium in the hour following the conclusion of the game. All other entities are not permitted to shoot live, transmit taped interviews for live broadcast or transmit live programming from inside NRG Stadium until one hour after the conclusion of the game.

Live shots and live streaming for transmission are NOT PERMITTED from the Texans post-game locker room for any entity.

## HOUSTON TEXANS MEDIA WEBSITE

To apply for game credentials, please submit your request on the website the Tuesday before a Texans home game by 5 p.m. CT.

Fans can access coverage on <http://www.HoustonTexans.com> throughout the season on Texans TV. The Texans broadcast live streaming video of press conferences, as well as game highlights, interviews, in-depth team features, community recaps, NFL Network footage and much more.

The complete 2014 Houston Texans Media Guide is available online at <http://media.houstontexans.com> and is updated after every game and team transaction.

Player bios and the Houston Texans record books are updated weekly during the season and are electronically distributed to media, as well as made available online at the Houston Texans media website.

The online version has been improved and is available in PDF format, allowing media to print, copy and paste information in an easier fashion. Player bios will be updated following each game, as will the roster, history and records sections. PDF versions of the media guide are available via email request. Printed versions of the media guide are available on a case-by-case basis.
