**TEXANS TEAM NOTES**

**THE TEXANS...**

- Gained 509 yards of offense, the fifth-most yards in a single game in franchise history and most since gaining 653 yards of offense in Week 11 of the 2012 season vs. Jacksonville (11/18/12)
- Gained the most yards of offense (509) at Seattle since the Steelers put up 538 yards of offense in Week 12 of the 2015 season against the Seahawks
- Scored 30-or-more points for the fifth straight game to extend the longest streak in franchise history and become the only team with 30-or-more points in five straight games this season
- Forced a fumble to remain the only team in the NFL with at least one forced fumble in every game this season
- Became the first team to score a touchdown on the Seahawks in the first quarter this season
- Became the first team to score a touchdown on the Seahawks in the fourth quarter this season
- Threw for 367 net passing yards, the most passing yards in a game for the Texans since Week 4 of the 2015 season at Atlanta (374)
- Gained 340-or-more yards on offense for the fifth-straight game, tied for the fourth-longest streak of 340-or-more yards gained in team history
- Converted their only fourth down attempt of the game and are now 3-for-4 on fourth down this season
- Had two receivers (WR **DeAndre Hopkins**- 224 and WR **Will Fuller V**- 125) with 100-or-more receiving yards for the first time since Week 2 of the 2016 season vs. Kansas City (9/18/16) when Hopkins had 113 and Fuller had 104
- Outgained the Seahawks with 509 total yards on offense (142 rushing and 367 passing) compared to 479 total yards (33 rushing and 446 passing) for Seattle
- Gained 25 first down (eight rushing, 15 passing and two by penalty) compared to 21 for Seattle (three rushing, 15 passing and three by penalty)
- Held Seattle to just 33 rushing yards, the least rushing yards allowed by the Texans since Week 11 of the 2016 season at Oakland (30) on 11/21/16

**SCORING PLAYS**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter – WR **Will Fuller V** caught a 59-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** on the Texans' opening drive, which was five plays for 75 yards (2:22). K **Ka'imi Fairbairn** made the extra point attempt

- 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter – RB **Lamar Miller** scored on a three-yard run following an eight-play, 82-yard drive (4:00) to give Houston a 14-7 lead after K **Ka’imi Fairbairn** made the extra point attempt
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter – WR **Will Fuller V** caught a 20-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** following an 11-play, 84-yard drive (5:06) to give Houston a 21-14 lead after K **Ka’imi Fairbairn** made the extra point attempt
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter – K **Ka’imi Fairbairn** made a 31-yard field goal to give Houston a 24-21 lead following a 10-play, 63-yard drive (4:19)
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter – RB **Lamar Miller** caught a two-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** following a five-play, 71-yard drive (2:16) to give Houston a 31-27 lead after K **Ka’imi Fairbairn** made the extra point attempt
- 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter – WR **DeAndre Hopkins** caught a 72-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** following a two-play, 75-yard drive (0:48) to give Houston a 38-34 lead after **Ka’imi Fairbairn** made the extra point attempt

#### MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- The following six Texans players were captains for the game: OLB/DE **Jadeveon Clowney**, T **Breno Giacomini**, WR **DeAndre Hopkins**, CB **Johnathan Joseph**, P **Shane Lechler** and ILB **Benardrick McKinney**
- The following seven Texans players were inactive for the game: T **Chris Clark**, ILB **Dylan Cole**, G **Kyle Fuller**, DE **Joel Heath**, ILB **Jelani Jenkins**, G **Dorian Johnson** and DE **Kendall Langford**
- The following player made his debut for the Texans: ILB **Ben Heeney**
- The following two Texans players were active but did not play in the game: CB **Treston Decoud** and QB **Tom Savage**
- Seattle won the toss and elected to defer. Houston received to start the game

## TEXANS INDIVIDUAL NOTES

#### OLB/DE JADEVEON CLOWNEY

- Finished with four total tackles (four solo), 1.0 sack, two tackles for loss, one quarterback hit and one forced fumble
- Sacked and forced a fumble on Seahawks QB **Russell Wilson** in the first quarter that was recovered by the Seahawks
- Has 4.0 sacks this season and 14.5 in his career
- Tied **Brooks Reed** (14.5) for the seventh-most sacks in franchise history
- Has forced a team-leading and single-season career high two fumbles this season and has four forced fumbles in his career

#### K KA’IMI FAIRBAIRN

- Scored eight total points on one made field goal and five made extra point attempts
- Extended his franchise-record streak for most consecutive field goals made to start a Texans career to 11
- Made a 31-yard field goal in the third quarter to give Houston a 24-21 lead
- One of two kickers in the NFL this season without a missed field goal (11-for-11), joining Cowboys K **Dan Bailey** (7-for-7)

#### WR WILL FULLER V

- Finished with five receptions for 125 yards (25.0 avg.) and two touchdowns
- Recorded his third 100-yard receiving game of his career and first this season. Houston is 2-1 when Fuller records 100-or-more receiving yards in a game
- Scored a touchdown on seven of his first 11 receptions this year. Since 1991, no player has reached seven receiving touchdowns on fewer receptions in a season
- First player in franchise history with six-or-more receiving touchdowns in a four-game span. Fuller has seven receiving touchdowns in the last four games
- Becomes fourth player in team history with a touchdown reception in four straight games, joining **DeAndre Hopkins** (2017- active streak), **Arian Foster** (2014) and **Andre Johnson** (2007 and 2010-11)
- Has three games with two-or-more receiving touchdowns this season, tied for the most games in a season with multiple touchdown receptions in franchise history (**Andre Johnson** in 2009 and **DeAndre Hopkins** in 2015)
- Has four receiving touchdowns of 20-or-more yards this season, which leads the NFL
- Scored a touchdown in all four games he has played in this season after missing Weeks 1-3 with an injury

- Caught a 59-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** on the Texans' opening drive to give Houston a 7-0 lead
- Caught a 20-yard touchdown pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** to give Houston a 21-14 lead in the second quarter
- Has seven receiving touchdowns this season and nine in his career

#### **WR DeANDRE HOPKINS**

- Finished with a team-high eight receptions for 224 yards (28.0 avg.) and one touchdown
- Recorded the second-most receiving yards in a game in his career. Hopkins had 238 receiving yards in Week 13 of the 2014 season vs. Tennessee (11/30/14)
- Recorded the most receiving yards in a game by any player in the NFL this season
- Becomes fourth player in team history with a touchdown reception in four straight games, joining **Will Fuller V** (2017- active streak), **Arian Foster** (2014) and **Andre Johnson** (2007 and 2010-11)
- Recorded his second 100-yard receiving game of the season and 15<sup>th</sup> of his career. Houston is 8-7 when Hopkins has 100-or-more receiving yards in his career
- Caught a 72-yard touchdown pass from QB Deshaun Watson in the fourth quarter to give Houston a 38-34 lead. It was the second longest reception of Hopkins' career
- Passed **Owen Daniels** (29) for the second-most receiving touchdowns in franchise history
- Passed **Owen Daniels** (29) for the third-most overall touchdowns in team history
- Reached 5,000 career receiving yards and 30 career receiving touchdowns
- Started his 71<sup>st</sup> straight game, which is the second-longest active streak among NFL wide receivers. Hopkins has recorded at least one reception in all 71 career games

#### **OLB LAMARR HOUSTON**

- Finished with three total tackles (two solo), one quarterback hit and two tackles for loss

#### **CB KAREEM JACKSON**

- Finished tied for second on the team with five total tackles (four solo), including one tackle for loss

#### **CB KEVIN JOHNSON**

- Finished tied for second on the team with five total tackles (three solo) and one pass defensed
- Played in his first game since Week 2 after missing Weeks 3-7 with an injury

#### **OLB UFOMBA KAMALU**

- Sacked Seahawks QB **Russell Wilson** for a loss of six yards in the third quarter
- Recorded his single-season career high second sack of the season and now has 3.0 sacks in his career

#### **P SHANE LECHLER**

- Punted five times for 265 yards (53.0 avg.), including a 63-yard punt, and pinned two punts inside the 20-yard line
- Reached 450 career punts inside the 20-yard line. Lechler is second all-time behind **Jeff Feagles** (554)
- Played in his 245th straight regular season game, which is the longest active streak in the NFL and passes **Chris Gardocki** (244) for the sixth-longest streak in NFL history

#### **ILB BENARDRICK MCKINNEY**

- Finished tied for second on the team with five total tackles (three solo)
- Passed **Whitney Mercilus** (228) for the 14th-most total tackles in team history

#### **RB LAMAR MILLER**

- Ran for 54 yards on a team-high 21 carries (2.6 avg.) and one touchdown
- Caught three passes for 19 yards (6.3 avg.) and one touchdown
- Recorded his second game with a rushing and receiving touchdown this season, joining **Arian Foster** as the only player in franchise history to accomplish the feat three times in his career as a Texan

- Scored his second receiving touchdown of the season on a two-yard pass from QB **Deshaun Watson** in the fourth quarter to give Houston a 31-27 lead. Miller has six career receiving touchdowns and two this season
- Scored his second rushing touchdown of the season on a three-yard run in the first quarter to give Houston a 14-7 lead. Miller has 26 career rushing touchdowns
- Passed **Derrick Ward** (six) for the eighth-most rushing touchdowns in team history with seven
- Passed **Jonathan Wells** (374) for the sixth-most carries in franchise history
- Continued his streak of 60-or-more scrimmage yards in every game this season and is one of three players with 60-or-more scrimmage yards in each of team's games this year (Saints RB **Mark Ingram** and Chiefs RB **Kareem Hunt**)

#### NT D.J. READER

- Finished with a team-high six total tackles (two solo), including one tackle for loss, and two quarterback hits

#### QB DESHAUN WATSON

- Completed 19-of-30 passes (63.3%) for 402 yards, four touchdowns, three interceptions and a 106.9 passer rating
- Ran for a team-high 67 yards on eight carries (8.4 avg.)
- Became the first player in NFL history with 400-or-more passing yards, four-or-more passing touchdowns and 50-or-more rushing yards in a single game
- Passed **Kurt Warner** for the most passing touchdowns (19) through a player's first seven career games in NFL history
- Has the most passing touchdowns (19) by a rookie in his first seven games in NFL history
- Has 18 passing touchdowns in his past five games, the most by a rookie over any five-game span in NFL history
- Became the fifth quarterback and first rookie in NFL history to have a five-game stretch with 225-or-more passing yards and 20-or-more rushing yards, joining **Andrew Luck** (2015-16), **Aaron Rodgers** (2016), **Daunte Culpepper** (2004) and **Randall Cunningham** (1990)
- Extended his rookie-record to four straight games with three-or-more passing touchdowns
- Tied **Peyton Manning**, **Marcus Mariota** and **Dak Prescott** for the most games (four) of three-or-more passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history
- Recorded his third game with four-or-more passing touchdowns, joining **Fran Tarkenton** (1961) as the only rookies in NFL history to accomplish feat
- Tied **Brian Hoyer** (19) for the fourth-most passing touchdowns in franchise history, passing **Ryan Fitzpatrick** (17) and **Brock Osweiler** (15)
- Passed **T.J. Yates** (1,470) for the eighth-most passing yards in Texans history
- Passed **Ryan Mallett** (119) for the ninth-most completions in team history
- Passed **Matt Schaub** (229) for the second-most rushing yards by a quarterback in team history
- Has thrown a touchdown pass of at least 35 yards in three straight games
- Led Houston on a five-play, 75-yard opening drive (2:22) that resulted in a 59-yard touchdown pass to WR **Will Fuller V** to give Houston a 7-0 lead in the first quarter
- Led Houston on an eight-play, 82-yard scoring drive (4:00) that resulted in a three-yard rushing touchdown by RB **Lamar Miller** to give Houston a 14-7 lead in the first quarter
- Led Houston on an 11-play, 84-yard scoring drive (5:06) that resulted in a 20-yard touchdown pass to WR **Will Fuller V** to give Houston a 21-14 lead in the second quarter
- Led Houston on a five-play, 71-yard scoring drive (2:16) that resulted in a two-yard touchdown pass to RB **Lamar Miller** to give Houston a 31-27 lead in the fourth quarter
- Completed a career-long 72-yard touchdown pass to WR **DeAndre Hopkins** to finish off a two-play, 75-yard scoring drive (0:48) in the fourth quarter to give Houston a 38-34 lead

#### CB MARCUS WILLIAMS

- Finished with four total tackles (four solo), one interception and one pass defensed
- Intercepted Seahawks QB **Russell Wilson** in the fourth quarter for his first interception of the season and the 10<sup>th</sup> interception of his career
